

Recycling

When loading garbage for the Transfer Stations, please keep in mind we have a separate WOOD bin and a separate METAL bin. These items are not put in with regular household garbage, but are recycled. So please keep the wood and metal separated out for easy recycling.

In addition Morrow County tries to keep access to all avenues of recycling available. Other recycling opportunities supported by Morrow County include: Morrow County residents are allowed to drop off televisions, computers and monitors, and all electronic waste **FREE** of charge Latex and oil based paints may be recycled **FREE** of charge to County residents; and items such as furniture, home appliances, washers, dryers, refrigerators, water heaters and mattresses be disposed of **FREE** of charge for Morrow County residents. These services have greatly reduced the amount of garbage that is left along our roads and ditches. Finley Buttes fees pay for these services.

Morrow County would like to remind you of the County Ordinance 5.010 Transportation of Solid Waste. *No person shall transport or self-haul, as defined in the Solid Waste Management Plan, solid waste on a public road unless such waste or solid waste is covered and secured.* Be aware that Morrow County will attach a \$10.00 fine to anyone not complying with this County Ordinance.
